Veteran Immunization Documentation Extension Request

NYS Title 10 regulations allow veterans with an honorable discharge status within the past 10 years to attend college while seeking armed services immunization records.

I, (print name) _____ D.O.B. _____ certify that I am a U.S. military veteran with an honorable discharge status, and understand that within 30 days from starting classes, all NYS college students must provide evidence of a meningitis vaccination review. I also understand that all NYS college students must prove immunity within 30 days to measles mumps and rubella, unless an allowable documentation deferral waiver applies.

I am applying for a Veteran's immunization documentation deferral, and am providing the following documentation to support this request:

Return of both of the above shall qualify me to attend Jefferson Community College, pending the receipt of either my complete Immunization records, or lab work which shows that I am immune to measles, mumps and rubella.

I understand this documentation deferral is not permanent, is limited to 10 years beyond my honorable discharge date, and that I must show a good faith effort to complete this documentation requirement (complete plan on back of form). While waived, in the event of an on-campus outbreak, I understand I will be excluded from participation in all on-campus classes and events for the duration of the outbreak.
